A Proclamation

ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS burns are a leading cause of injury and death, and

WHEREAS it is vital to the health and well-being of all our citizens to have Public Education Programmes in both the causes and prevention of burns, and

WHEREAS Hospital Burn Units rely greatly on the assistance of the fire service for Burn Injury Awareness, and

WHEREAS Our Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, has been pleased to enact Order in Council 903 on October 11, 2002;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that the week of February 1 to 7, 2009, inclusive, shall be known as

"Burn Awareness Week"

in the Province of British Columbia.
