Poster & NEW Video Contest

The 2018 theme is:
'Look. Listen. Learn. Be aware. Fire can happen anywhere.'

POSTER CONTEST RULES:

- Posters must be drawn on an 8 ½ by 11 inch letter-sized paper, 1 entry per student.
- Poster artwork may be drawn on any Burn Awareness Week program fire safety subject.
- The contest is open to any student residing in British Columbia — from Kindergarten through to Grade 7. Students can participate on their own without the participation of their school.
- Posters must include the child's name, grade, school & address on the back of the poster.
- Submitted posters are based on age-appropriate skill, and will be judged on message and content.

POSTER CONTEST PRIZES:

Prizes are awarded to fifty students in five areas throughout the province of British Columbia. The areas include: Lower Mainland (three prizes), Vancouver Island, Kootenay, Northern BC and the Okanagan. One of the seven Regional Prize Winners will also be chosen as the Grand Prize Winner. All posters will be displayed on the Burn Fund's website www.burnfund.org for one year and distributed via social media and other Burn Fund Publications.

Grand Prize Winner will receive **\$1,000** for their elementary school or BC Ministry of Education sanctioned facility, a pizza party for their class and a Dalmatian toy for themselves. The winner's poster will be used in promotional material where appropriate. The winner will receive a Burn Fund recognition plaque, pizza party for their class, and a Dalmatian toy to recognize their contribution to Burn Awareness.

Regional Prize Winners will receive **\$500** for their elementary school or BC Ministry of Education sanctioned facility, a pizza party for their class, a Dalmatian toy, and a framed certificate.

Honorable Mention Winners will receive **\$50** for their elementary school or BC Ministry of Education sanctioned facility, and a Dalmatian toy for themselves.

All Poster Contest Entrants will receive a participation prize which will be sent to their school and handed out by teachers of participating classes.

VIDEO CONTEST RULES:

- Students grades 4 - 7 are invited to create a maximum 3 minute video that contains a strong Burn Awareness Week message and relates to the current year's theme.
- Participants can create a video to share their burn prevention and fire safety ideas. All submissions must be posted on YouTube by October 13th, 2018.
- Think of a creative way to get your message across in your video. All styles of video are accepted: drama, comedy, documentary, music video, stop-motion, claymation, or animation.
- Submitted videos are based on age-appropriate skill, and will be judged on message and content.

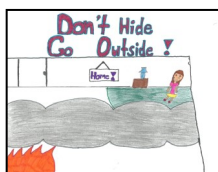
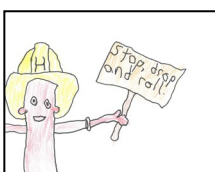
VIDEO CONTEST PRIZES:
