



# Coordinate a Too Hot for Tots! Workshop

## Workshop Details

*Too Hot for Tots!* is an evidence-based, early childhood injury prevention program. This workshop is geared to Family Educators and Fire Fighters who work with families with children aged 0-6.

During this 8 hour workshop you will;

- Learn why burns and scalds happen and what can be done to prevent these injuries.
- Receive a *Too Hot for Tots!* Toolkit containing educator and caregiver resources for your centre.
- Learn how to deliver the *Too Hot for Tots!* Caregiver Presentation. This presentation teaches caregivers about the common burn hazards in their home and how to keep their young children safe.
- Receive an 8 hour training certificate upon course completion.

## About the BC Professional Fire Fighters' Burn Fund

The Burn Fund was established as a registered charity in 1978.

More than 4,000 professional fire fighters in BC and the Yukon dedicate their time and skills to support burn survivors and increase public awareness of fire and burn safety issues through research, support and prevention programs.

Workshop facilitators will travel to most cities within BC. All costs associated with hosting this workshop will be covered by the BC Professional Fire Fighters' Burn Fund with the exception of the registration fee.

## Booking a Workshop – Host Responsibilities

1. **Decide** on the workshop location, date and time. *\*Please note: 6 weeks is the minimum length of time required to organize and promote a workshop.*
2. **Submit a Workshop Request Form**. You will then be sent an email confirming the date, time and location of your workshop as well as a customized promotional *Too Hot for Tots!* flyer to advertise to your staff and network organizations.
3. **Registration** – Registration fee is \$40 per person. Workshop size 5–30 people. You will be responsible for gathering registration and paying on behalf of all the registrants. Information about the registration process will be included in the confirmation email. Payment for all participants must be received at least two weeks prior to workshop.
4. **Advertise** broadly to your staff and partner organizations with the customized promotional *Too Hot for Tots!* flyer.
5. **Order** Materials and Toolkit two weeks prior to the workshop date. Information about how to order will be included in the confirmation email. These items are complimentary and will be mailed to you at no additional cost.
